Dear Parishioners and Friends,

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!

On behalf of all of us here at SEAS, I'd like to wish a Happy Father's Day to all our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, stepfathers, foster fathers, and all those who have been a "father" to us in one way or another.

Like some of you, my dad, my grandfathers, my godfather are all with the Lord. Actually, this summer it will be 35 years since my dad died from pancreatic cancer. He was 59 years old, and if I make it to July when I turn 60, I and my 3 siblings will all have outlived our parents (mom was 48 when she died in 1977). I never knew my grandfathers since my maternal grandfather died when my mom was only three years old, and my paternal grandfather died when I was just 1 year old. Nonetheless, all of these men, in one way or another, had great influence on my life. In reality, either from my personal experience of them, or from the stories I've heard, they each reflected a different image of God: as one who cares, as one who loves unconditionally, as one who works sometimes in the background, as one who sees a need and responds without counting the cost. And so, we all give thanks to God for all the special men in our lives. May God bless them each on this special day!

CONGRATULATIONS AUXILIARY BISHOP-ELECT GREGORY GORDON!

I never expected that we would get an auxiliary bishop here in Las Vegas, but God has blessed us with **Monsignor Gregory Gordon** who has been called to service in the church as an auxiliary bishop. As I mentioned in our video announcements a couple of weeks ago, an auxiliary bishop is an assistant to Bishop Thomas, much like a parochial vicar (associate pastor) is to a pastor. Bishop Thomas is a very busy bishop serving on several boards and committees, some with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). Bishop-elect Gordon (as he is now addressed) continues to serve our diocese as the Vicar General, Moderator of the Curia and Chancellor. He has helped me deal with some

sensitive situations, all with a pastoral heart.

Bishop-elect Gordon has quite the background. After college and seminary in Pennsylvania, he studied in Rome before being ordained a priest on January 16, 1988. He received a Bachelor of Sacred Theology (STB) from the Pontifical Gregorian University (1986) and a Licentiate of Sacred Theology (STL) from the Pontifical Lateran University (1987). He served in several parishes and then was assigned to the Apostolic Nunciature in Washington, D.C. in service to the Papal Nuncio, the Pope's representative in the United States, from 2007-2014.

Bishop-elect Gordon will be ordained to the episcopacy on July 16, 2021. He will serve here in the Diocese of Las Vegas as our first ever auxiliary bishop! Upon hearing of his appointment, I texted him my congratulations and added: "I foresee plans for bigger things in your future!" Let's see if my intuitions are spot-on or not.

Anyway, Congratulations Bishop-Elect Gregory! Blessings to you on your new call from the Church!

CONGRATULATIONS NEWLY ORDAINED FATHER MAURICIO ESPINO

Please ignore anyone who promotes a demonic association with this pandemic or its vaccines. That nonsense has already cost too many lives.

So, please know that it is morally acceptable to receive the vaccine and that there is no connection to anything evil or demonic. I would hate to lose anyone else who refuses a vaccine out of this unfounded fear.

The Collection: A Privilege

As the altar is prepared for the celebration of the Eucharist, the collection is taken up. In the early church, this part of the Mass must have been something to behold, as the people suddenly began to move, bringing forward to the deacons and priests freshly-baked bread and fine wine. Then, after the Eucharistic Prayer, that same community came forward again in the Communion procession, and they received back the very gifts they had given, now transformed into something infinitely more precious than bread and wine: the very Body and Blood of Christ.

Beginning around the eleventh century, it became the custom for people to present money instead of bread and wine, and the procession of the faithful gradually disappeared (it survives in the liturgy of Holy Thursday). But the meaning is the same. We continue to bring the fruit of our labors and to offer them freely to God. And God continues to transform them into Christ. It is through our generous sharing of time, talent, and treasure that our parishes can preach the gospel, reach out to the sick and the imprisoned, and celebrate the sacraments.

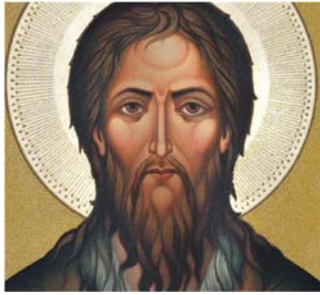

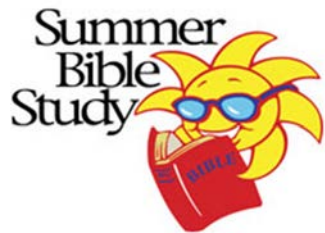
Saint of the Week

Nativity of John the Baptist

Dates: First Century
Feast Day: June 24

In the Gospels, John, a kinsman of Jesus through their mothers, preached repentance and baptized to prepare for the Messiah's coming. This feast marks his exceptional birth to the aged priest Zechariah and the equally aged and barren Elizabeth. The angel Gabriel announces his birth in a vision to Zechariah, who hesitates in believing and is struck mute until eight days after John's birth. Then, Zechariah, in a beautiful canticle that ends the first chapter of Luke's Gospel, proclaims that John "will be called prophet of the Most High." John's eventual beheading is commemorated with an Aug. 29 feast. A patron saint of Canada and Jordan, John is also the patron of Florence and the Knights Hospitaller of St. John.

Stewardship: The Path to Discipleship

By the Most Reverend Thomas Wenski, Archbishop of Miami, excerpted from his 2019 pastoral letter "Stewardship and the Theology of the Gift."

I wish to share with you some reflections on stewardship. A proper understanding of our role as "stewards of God's varied grace" can help us truly be "missionary disciples."

Made in His own image and likeness, God made us for Himself and in his plan; he has made us stewards of his creation that we might respond to his love in kind so that, cooperating with him, we use our gifts for his greater honor and glory.

Stewardship — placing our time, talent and treasure at his disposal — is then the path of discipleship by which we grow in our friendship with God, and with one another, becoming in Christ, through the gift of the Holy Spirit, the persons that God meant for us to be.

Of course, in inviting us to "come, follow him," Jesus calls us to walk the "narrow path." As we make our life's pilgrimage through this "vale of tears," this path will take us by the Way of the Cross, the way of Jesus who sacrificed himself for us and for our salvation. In fact, the Bishops at the Second Vatican Council insisted that as human beings we can only fully realize ourselves through the sincere gift of ourselves in imitation of Christ.

Seen in this way, stewardship is not just a "program" to increase the Sunday offertory. It is really something much more demanding. More than a "fundraising" gimmick, stewardship rightly understood is a way of life. So, it is something much more difficult than just writing a check. Becoming a disciple of Jesus Christ, given our fallen human nature, goes against the grain of our propensity for self-seeking, self-assertion and self-realization. (Isn't the multiplication of warehouses that rent space for "self-storage" a sad commentary on our culture of acquisitiveness?)

But a good steward accepts joyfully the risks of

discipleship. To be a friend of Jesus calls us to "come out of ourselves." However, this is not a burden imposed upon us. To be a Christian is far from being a burden, it is a gift — and, to follow Christ, offering him in return our own gifts of time, talent and treasure, brings us joy, a joy that gives meaning and direction to our lives.

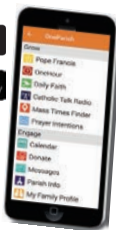

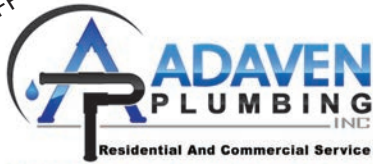
