MERCY FLOWS, LOVE REDEEMS

Dear Parishioners and Friends of SEAS,

THE JUBILEE YEAR OF ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI

Pope Leo XIV has declared a Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi to mark the 800th Centenary of his death in 1226. The Jubilee Year is from January 10, 2026, through January 10, 2027. We're a little behind in acknowledging this observance, but it's "better late than never." I have to admit, however, that being late on this observance is particularly embarrassing for me who spent 34 years of my life (1979-2013) associated with the Conventual Franciscans as a candidate, novice, professed member and finally as a priest! I ask St. Francis to forgive me!

As many roads have twists and turns, they still lead to a destination. My life as a Conventual Franciscan had twists and turns which eventually led me to this destination in the Archdiocese of Las Vegas. My formation as a Conventual Franciscan has accompanied me through my own twists and turns and has formed and continues to form me to this very day. I learned about the poor man of Assisi as a man of peace who knew of that peace through his own love relationship with God. As Francis left behind his family's riches which he would have inherited, he found peace without the burden of material possessions. As he grew in his relationship with God, he knew that his call was simply to live the Gospel. As he embraced the Gospel, everything fell into place. And here we are, 800 years after his death, and still remembering the little poor man of Assisi as one who was most like Christ.

St. Francis didn't have any intention to begin a religious order, but it sort of just happened. His joy was so infectious that others started to follow him as he erroneously thought he was supposed to fix up dilapidated churches. For it was in the run-down chapel of San Damiano that he heard the voice of Christ speak to him from the crucifix, "Francis, go repair my church which, you see, is falling into ruin." He thought the message was literal, and so he started to rebuild the San Damiano chapel. Only later would he come to know, through his own twists and turns, that he was to help repair the institutional Church of his day. You see, even 800 years ago, the Church wasn't perfect!

The way Francis was really supposed to build up the institutional Church was through his humble example of peacefully living the Gospel. He had the uncanny gift to see the presence of God in all of creation, including those humans most despised: the lepers. He physically embraced the leper, and in doing so he embraced Christ.

And so, even to this very day, St. Francis is an example for all of us, especially in this Jubilee Year, to be people who embrace, who welcome everyone created by God. Francis never wanted his followers to be "little Francises," but "little Christs!" He was famous for saying to his brothers, "I have done my part. May Christ teach you yours!"

I'm sure I'll be sharing some reflections on the poor man of Assisi throughout this Jubilee Year. But, be aware, St. Francis' example for ALL of Christ's disciples can be quite challenging. His living of the unconditional love of God for ALL creation, including ALL humans, is not for the faint of heart or for those whose self-righteousness puts them above others. Those who live without any humility will certainly be threatened by the message of St. Francis, and then despise and criticize those who simply live the Gospel. It happened in the time of Francis, and it happens in ours as well.

And yet, in God's wisdom and providence, we are gifted at this very time in history with this special Jubilee Year to remind us of the joy that comes with humility and simplicity. To know the love of God is to live the love of God, without condition, without exception.

Therefore, let us join Pope Leo XIV in his Prayer for this Jubilee Year:

Saint Francis, our brother, you who eight hundred years ago went to meet Sister Death as a man at peace, intercede for us before the Lord.

You recognized true peace in the Crucifix of San Damiano: teach us to seek in Him the source of all reconciliation that breaks down every wall.

You who, unarmed, crossed the lines of war and misunderstanding, give us the courage to build bridges where the world raises up boundaries.

In this time afflicted by conflict and division, intercede for us so that we may become peacemakers: unarmed and disarming witnesses of the peace that comes from Christ. Amen.

VIRTUES EXPLAINED

Diligence, *Explained*

Diligence is the opposite of negligence; the diligent man pursues his goal with the same faithfulness with which God has pursued us, wayward as we are, through the long course of salvation history. St. Thomas Aquinas writes that "diligence, no less than solicitude, is required for every virtue." (Sum., II:II, 54, Art. 1)

Christians are called to diligence in prayer, in self-scrutiny, in exercising virtue, in seeking God's will, in detachment from the world and in reflecting on God's word in Scripture: "If we are diligent in observing all of these commandments before the Lord, our God, as he commanded of us, then this will be our righteousness." (Deuteronomy 6:25)

Diligence is made possible by the freedom of will that we have been granted by God, and it is the virtue by which man can secure for himself true happiness. (Gaudium et spes, 17)

WORSHIP & MEDITATION

LITURGY GOSPEL MEDITATIONS

5th Sunday of Easter — John 14:1-12

We generally approach life with the question, "What can this do for me?" We try a new workout, a low-carb diet, intermittent fasting, or a new career path, hoping it will make us healthier, stronger, happier. The assumption is that if I invest in this, I'll eventually reap some benefit, or I won't do it.

It is easy to think of faith the same way: if I really practice my faith, what will it do for me? Will it make me calmer, more moral, more successful?

But in today's Gospel, Jesus says something astonishing. He doesn't present himself as a teacher who shows us the way to life. He says, **"I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life."** (John 14:6) He is not merely a guide toward some higher benefit. He is the benefit itself. To know him is to know Life.

Thomas Aquinas explains that every desire in the human heart — love, joy, meaning, all of our restless cravings — is really an indirect cry for life. Even despair testifies to this longing: people despair precisely because they feel they are not, and might never be, fully alive.

The good news is that Jesus is not simply the means to a better life; He is Life itself. To believe in him is to share in God's own eternal vitality. Not simply later but even now. Faith is not a transaction that produces results — it is a union that fills us with joy. To be in communion with Christ is to be truly, fully alive.

A friend of mine who had family members belonging to several different religions once told me that there were as many different routes to Heaven as there were to the grocery store. This was an analogy her family had used to remember that they all sought the same thing — God — even though they were going about the search in different ways.

I've thought a lot about her words in the years since she shared them with me. It's not an untrue analogy — there are a lot of different routes to the grocery store. An infinite number, in fact. There is actually no "right" way to get to the grocery store, because it all depends on where you're starting from and what other errands you have along the way.

And there are a lot of different routes to Heaven — likewise, an infinite number. It all depends on where you're starting from. It all depends on what you have to do along the way. There it is: the part that matters. The way.

Whether we're talking about Heaven or the grocery store as our destination, all routes are not created equal. Some take too long. Some are impassable. Some are hard to navigate. Some are just plain made-up — the glitch of a GPS, the promise of a false prophet. And inevitably, if you take a less-than-ideal route, you will find yourself flagging down a pedestrian, asking, "I'm lost. Which way do I go?"

See, you can meander all you want. But in the end, you have to find The Way. And there's only one. Don't worry, though. You'll know him when you see him.

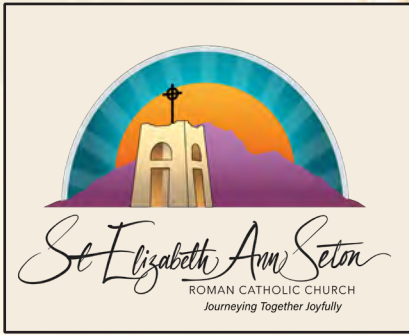

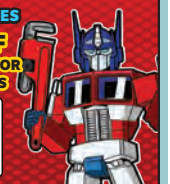
