
ST. ELIZABETH ANN SETON PARISH BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM (2020-2021)



The shortest of the four gospels, Mark is the earliest account of Jesus' life and the primary source for the other synoptic Gospels, Matthew and Luke. With no mention of Jesus' infancy, Mark begins with Jesus' baptism in the Jordan by John and climaxes with the announcement of his resurrection to the women at the tomb. Mark asks everyone to answer Jesus' question, **'Who do you say that I am?'** and challenges believers in every generation to accept the harsh reality of the cross. Beginning in December, 2020 most of the readings we will hear at Mass during this year will come from the Gospel of Mark ... so what a perfect time to join this 10-session study as we explore Mark's theological portrait of the person and mission of Jesus Christ.
