LETTER TO THE ROMANS

St. Paul is one of the most important figures in the history of Christianity. His letters significantly shaped the development of Christian theology and doctrine, while his missionary work helped spread Christianity throughout the ancient Mediterranean world. The Letter to the Romans, whom many consider Paul's "masterpiece," presents the longest and most systematic unfolding of Paul's thought. In it, Paul lays out a powerful doctrine of the supremacy of Christ and of faith in Christ as the source of salvation. Romans holds significant importance for Catholics primarily because it provides a foundation for our understanding of salvation, faith, relationships within the Church, and the importance of not only what we believe but how we live out those beliefs in our daily lives. Sessions are offered on Monday evenings (6:30-8:00 pm) and repeated/livestreamed on Wednesday mornings (9:30-11:00 am) in the St. John XXIII conference room. The commentary we will be using for this 9-week study is "Galatians and Romans." If you already have that commentary from an earlier study, cost is \$20 to cover materials and hospitality.
