MERCY FLOWS, LOVE REDEEMS

Dear Parishioners and Friends of SEAS,

HAVE MERCY ON US, AND ON THE WHOLE WORLD

During his papacy, St. John Paul II revived the Divine Mercy devotion to be celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. Since then, it's been one of my most favorite devotions. It's also the most challenging devotion. Given the tense situations around the world these days, we need this devotion now, more than ever.

Why is it the most challenging? Well, in the text of the devotion we pray that God may "have mercy on us and on the whole world." Asking for God's mercy upon us is one thing. Asking for his mercy on the whole world is quite another! We pray for his mercy on the **WHOLE** world: not just for some, not just for those we like, but on the **WHOLE** world.

Recently, we've heard individuals invoking God for the destruction of those who do not deserve mercy. What child of God has the right to decide who deserves mercy? What child of God can tell God who is deserving of mercy or not? The answer is simple: no one has authority over God, no one can determine who is worthy of God's mercy or not.

So, this Divine Mercy Sunday challenges us to go beyond ourselves and ask God to have mercy even on those most difficult to love! Remember, it's been said, "You will never look into the eyes of someone God doesn't love!"

Jesus gave us the greatest example of mercy when he was praying from the cross for those who were brutally murdering him! He selflessly prayed that God would forgive them, and then he even made excuses for them stating that "they do not know what they are doing!"

Our beloved Pope Leo XIV is likewise calling us to let God's mercy live through us, as we strive to let the peace of Christ live in and through us. May this Divine Mercy Sunday inspire us to sincerely pray that God may "have mercy on us and on the **WHOLE** world!"

How does Christ prove himself to Thomas? Not by his face or his words, but by his wounds. So, when we look for God to show Himself in relief or in triumph, we must remember the wounds of Christ. This is where we find our salvation.

VIRTUES EXPLAINED

Fortitude, *Explained*

"When you go out to war against your enemies and you see horses and chariots and an army greater than your own, you shall not be afraid of them," we read in Deuteronomy 20:1. "For the Lord, your God...will be with you."

The virtue of fortitude actually requires, first and foremost, the feeling of fear. In order to grow in fortitude, one must face a thing which frightens him; in that way, it is distinct from patience and perseverance. Christ shows perfect fortitude as he endures his Passion and death, of which he was indeed afraid; it is likewise shown by martyrs. But fortitude doesn't require a cinematic battle. Fortitude can be shown by someone who is afraid of losing his job or of being in bodily danger simply for adhering to the laws of God. What is important is that the courage shown is *in pursuit of the good*, not just bearing with an attack.

LITURGY GOSPEL MEDITATIONS

2nd Sunday of Easter (Sunday of Divine Mercy) — John 20:19-31

"Then he said to Thomas, 'Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe.'" (John 20:27)

In my early 20s, I volunteered at a parish youth group. I witnessed teens encountering Jesus with a fresh, romantic wonder that reminded me of my own teenage conversion. But something had changed in me. I was quietly jaded and cynical. When teens shared stories of encountering Christ, I'd want to sarcastically murmur, "Well, good for you." I had grown suspicious of the zeal I once knew.

Then we brought the group on a pilgrimage. I was standing in an old church in France, ignoring a long-winded tour guide. I found myself before a crucifix. In that moment, I heard something, not audibly, but unmistakably in my heart: "I came to be your friend... and you wish to be my enemy? Why do you stand far from me? I suffer gladly for you. I was pierced for you. Why do you run from me?" My heart opened. I saw how cold and cynical I had become. But Jesus had not given up on me. He had returned, and his mercy broke through.

So I can relate to the scoffing — and transformation — of Thomas when the Risen Jesus presents his wounds for inspection. Thomas is not simply doubting; he is guarded, suspicious, even cynical. But Jesus comes to him. No lecture. Just understanding and mercy. He invites Thomas to touch his wounds. This burns away his cynicism like the morning mist.

Divine Mercy Challenge: This week, rejoice with someone who is newly alive in faith. If your own heart has grown skeptical or tired, ask Jesus to help you. He will.

PRACTICING CATHOLIC

Within Thy Wounds

The prayer I love best in the world is the Anima Christi. This private, devotional litany of supplication, begins with the phrase *"anima Christi, sanctifica me"* ("soul of Christ, sanctify me") and continues on to appeal individually to each aspect of Our Lord's crucified flesh: *"Body of Christ, save me; blood of Christ, inebriate me; water from Christ's side, wash me; passion of Christ, strengthen me; Oh good Jesus, hear me."* Then comes my favorite part: *"within thy wounds hide me."*

The Anima Christi is a prayer traditionally said after receiving Holy Communion. The ancient Celts spoke of *liminal places*, where the veil separating this world from the next is particularly thin, and I believe the moments immediately following the reception of Holy Communion, when the Host is dissolving on my tongue, create a liminal place. When I am in that place, I am as intimately connected to God as I can be while my heart is still beating. And when I am there, holding God within me, what are the words that I speak? It's overwhelming to think about. What could possibly be right to say? There is no right or wrong answer, I suppose. But the best words I can think of are these: "Within thy wounds, Lord, hide me."

There is a reason Christ showed his wounds as he said the words, "Peace be with you." It was not just a means of identifying himself — it was a catechism lesson. *Here*, he was saying. *Here is the peace you will not find anywhere else.*

How Often Do We REALLY Pray?

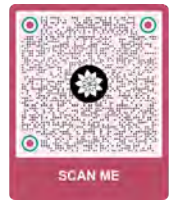
