Dear Parishioners and Friends of SEAS,

IT'S GOOD TO BE BACK!

After being away for nearly two weeks, it's good to be back home and doing what I love best! The only problem in coming back from time away is trying to get caught up on things that need my attention. But, thanks to the amazing staff here at SEAS, the load waiting for me is very manageable! I'm surrounded by good people who keep this great ministry going despite my absence.

MY HEALTH UPDATE

The main purpose for this recent trip to Arizona was to seek additional input into how to deal with the cancerous neuroendocrine tumor in my pancreas. In addition to blood work, I underwent a PET scan to investigate if there has been any spread of the cancer. What did show up was a "suspicious nodule" on the left side of my thyroid gland. Long story short, my final test last Monday, August 24th, was an ultrasound thyroid biopsy. I'm happy to report that there was no malignancy detected with this biopsy! Thanks be to God!

The other test I underwent was an MRI to evaluate the status or growth of the neuroendocrine tumor. The doctors with whom I met were in agreement that the invasive "Whipple Procedure" is not an option for me due to the high probability of complications from the surgery. We will continue to monitor the tumor's growth while also evaluating various options for possible treatments to stunt the growth of this slow-growing tumor. A team of doctors met to discuss my case. Issues with my phone prohibited me from discussing these options thus far. Now that I'm back at home, I'll be able to better communicate with the lead doctor and discuss possible future options for treatment of the tumor.

I have to give a big "shout-out" to the Phoenix campus of Mayo Clinic. Every test and every appointment was so well organized, and the care from everyone was amazing! A couple of my best friends, Barb Badalewski and Eileen McNally, accompanied me during the Mayo Clinic portion of my time away. It's good to have another set of ears and eyes to help me keep the information clear.

And, as always, I appreciate your continued prayers, concern and support. I know I'm not walking this journey alone and appreciate your spiritual accompaniment. I'll keep you informed of any further developments as time goes on.

AN UPDATE ON FR. SHAWN DRESDEN

While in Arizona, I had the opportunity to visit twice with Fr. Shawn, our former parochial vicar, as he journeys through his own struggles with cancer. He recently underwent a 16 hour surgery at Mayo's and is recuperating well. After a few months of healing, he will need to undergo another surgery. He continues to inspire me with his strength and determination to move forward. So, please continue to remember Fr. Shawn in prayer during his time of recuperation.

VIRTUES EXPLAINED

Zeal, Explained

Zeal gets a bad rap these days, as we most often hear this word associated with extremists whose adherence to a belief system leads them to violence. In Scripture, we hear Paul condemn those whose “zeal for God” lacks discernment (Romans 10:2), so we know this was a problem in ancient times as well.

But no one acting in violence or hatred is practicing virtuous zeal, which refers to an all-consuming love for the Lord: “Zeal for your house has consumed me,” writes the Psalmist (Psalm 69:10), referring to a religious devotion that has deprived him of all his worldly status.

If anyone’s “love” of God leads him to sin, he is not actually motivated by love of God. A burning and all-consuming love of God has, for its object, God Himself — and closeness with God is impeded by anything contrary to the teachings of Jesus Christ.

WORSHIP & MEDITATION

LITURGY GOSPEL MEDITATIONS

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time — Matthew 16:21-27

Do you know what it is like to be thrilled by the power of Christian faith one moment and then utterly fail in it the next? I do. That is Peter in today's Gospel. After last week's bold confession, he now hears Jesus speak of suffering and death, and something in him recoils. He takes Jesus aside and tries to correct him. Jesus responds with the shocking rebuke, **"Get behind me, Satan."**

Peter is the mirror of every disciple. We love Jesus until he contradicts the script we have written for our lives. Peter does not reject Jesus. He rejects a suffering Jesus. So do we, whenever we avoid a hard responsibility, resist a demanding relationship, or cling to comfort instead of choosing love. We want a Lord who supports our plans, not one who overturns them.

Yet Jesus does not discard Peter. He redirects him. **"Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me."** In effect, Jesus says, stop trying to lead me. Let me lead you. Discipleship does not begin with heroism or clarity but with surrender. It means trusting that God's path to life often passes through places we would never choose.

Peter is all of us. We move from insight to confusion, from confidence to correction. That is why we should have hope. Jesus patiently teaches us again and again. Trust me. Get behind me. Follow me. When we stop fighting the crosses that come and start carrying them with him, we discover a freedom deeper than comfort and a love stronger than fear.

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WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question: Why do priests wear vestments? Do they have a special meaning?

Answer: Vestments are clothes worn for a specific purpose. Priests will joke that they cover a thousand flaws. But our own manner of dress often corresponds to what we do. We dress up for special occasions and for special guests. We wear certain clothes for golf, for outdoor activities, and years ago, we even had our "Sunday best" clothes we wore just for Church. Vestments are much the same, and each one has a meaning. The alb is a reminder of the baptismal garment. The stole is a symbol of ordained ministry and authority within the Church. The chasuble reminds us that we are on a pilgrimage of faith, passing through this life towards heaven.

Priests wear vestments for two basic reasons. First, they draw attention to the importance and solemnity of the act of worship. The color of the vestments indicates the season of the year or the feast being celebrated. Secondly, vestments draw attention to what the priest does, rather than who he is. In the celebration of the Mass, the focus is on what we do together, on our common unity, and on the mystery and person of Christ.

QUESTIONS OF THE WEEK

First Reading: Jeremiah wrestles with an inner struggle to proclaim the word of the Lord that comes to him. Who helps you work through distress or anxiety?

Second Reading: Paul challenges believers not to conform to the present age but be transformed by the renewal of their minds. What in our "present age" needs to be avoided?

Gospel: Peter does not want to accept Jesus' destiny as the Messiah who suffers greatly and dies. How do you process difficult news or information?

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PRACTICING CATHOLIC

To Carry the Cross

Carry the cross? Absolutely. I'm happy to! Hand it over. Here's the thing: I just might...set it down for a second, from time to time. That's okay, right? How else am I supposed to have both hands free to gesture in anger? I can't do that if I'm carrying the cross. Well, fine, then let me just shift its weight, so I can catch my breath and say what I think about this person who's got it all wrong — I'll just lean it against the wall here. No? Okay, fine, I won't put it down! I'll keep holding it. That's better, actually. Then I can use it as a weapon.

What? Am I doing this "Christian" thing wrong?

"Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it," Jesus tells us in today's Gospel. "But whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." This is not an affirmation of the paradox that if you no longer care about something, you can finally have it once and for all. It's not a judgment about the worthlessness of life in this fallen world or the futility of trying to preserve that life. It's merely a statement about priorities.

When Peter says, "God forbid!" at the thought of suffering, God is not his priority. His own safety is. When I say, "God forbid!" at anything that comes from the mouth of God, it's a reminder to look at my hands — because they've probably put down the cross.

How merciful is our Lord — he never takes my cross from me, even when I walk far away from it. He always lets me pick it back up. In his dear and sweet goodness, he even helps me lift its weight. And he gestures, in case I've forgotten: "This way. Follow me."

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Reminder Regarding Back Pedestrian Gate

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton parish is committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of our parishioners and guests. Now that school is back in session, here is a reminder regarding procedures when using the back pedestrian gate leading from Cielo Vista Avenue to the front of the church and chapel.

The gate leading to the front of the church from Cielo Vista Avenue is locked during the week as a way to limit access to the church from back streets. Daily Mass attendees need to park in the main church parking lot.

The front gate (nearest the Chapel) will remain open daily for deliveries EXCEPT on Thursdays when we have School Mass. Then, the front gate will also be locked during the School Mass.

Please note: This only applies to weekdays. The back gate is open on weekends to accommodate the large number of people who use Cielo Vista as additional church parking.

Whenever exiting through a locked push bar door, you must make sure the door is closed behind you. Do NOT leave it open.

Assistive Listening Devices Available

For those who are hearing impaired or may have difficulty understanding what is said during Mass due to background noise, distance from the speakers, or echo in the church, we offer assistive listening devices to help get past hearing obstacles. Each wireless unit comes with an earpiece that sits over the top of the ear or you can attach your own mini jack (3.5mm) ear buds or headphones. The units can be borrowed from the reception desk located inside the gift shop. Please remember to return them to the receptionist after Mass so they will be available for others to use.

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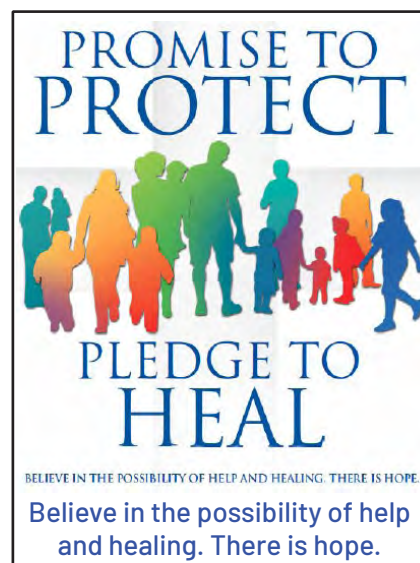
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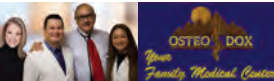
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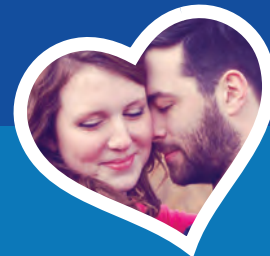
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
