On the weekend of March 29-30, our Archdiocese will take up the national collection for Catholic Relief Services (CRS), a vital initiative that brings aid and hope to those in need around the world.

The U.S. government recently suspended funding for its refugee resettlement program and terminated cooperative agreements, directly impacting thousands of refugees under the care of the USCCB. Additionally, abrupt stop-work orders on foreign humanitarian aid have left organizations like Catholic Relief Services struggling to sustain essential efforts— providing food, life-saving medicine, and daily necessities to vulnerable communities.
